

**RCV balls driveshaft suppresses the disadvantages of double joint :**

*Constant velocity*

*Sizes*

*Inner plays*

*Inertia*

*Narrow ball bearing*

*Servicing*

**With RCV balls driveshaft :**

*Tire works better*

*Improve lateral grip*

*Improve traction*

*Steering radius shorter & more constant*

*Increase front reactivity*

*Increase rear stability*

*The stability gain of the rear is very appreciable with the new Mid motor chassis*

**RCV balls driveshaft is the perfect association with active rear system (ARS) :**

*Less toe-in = More speed limit (with "stock" motor)*

*Less toe-in in compression = Less braking in curve*
